

PRINTED CIRCUIT BOARD LAYOUT CHART FOR 2' X 4' PANEL BOARD

This chart is used to layout the printed circuit boards (PCBs) on a 2 foot by 4 foot piece of Pre-Drilled Panel Board or plywood. You should first print out the layout and circuit board diagrams from the Track Configuration Library that correspond to your layout. Then convert the block numbers, target numbers and turnout letters to those on your signal plan. After you have completed that, you can use this chart to layout the placement of the PCBs on the plywood. You can slide some configurations left or right so that they share the same columns, but try to follow the TCL as closely as possible. Once that is done, use arrows to show the interconnections between the PCBs.
